
TORO CENTENARIO

Manual harvesting.
Reception and destemming.
Fermentation with selected yeasts at controlled temperatura in stainless steel tanks.
Clarification.
Filtration.
Bottling.

Aging

4 months in French Oak Barrel.

Tasting Notes

This wine exhibits a bright ruby red color with violet hues, accompanied by aromas of black pepper and green peppers, followed by red fruits such as cherries. On the palate it is very balanced, with soft, sweet and persistent tannins.
