Tasting Notes

This wine exhibits an intense bright red color with violet hues, accompanied by fruity aromas such as cherries and plums, followed by hints of vanilla from the contact with oak. On the palate it has a friendly entry with good structure, soft and round tannins, very balanced and long finish.
